



## Instructions to Presenters

### Presentation types

The 27th World Meeting on Sexual Medicine will feature six types of abstract presentations:

- **Oral Presentations** will be granted 4 minutes for presentation, followed by 1 minute for discussion.
- **Oral Presentations in a Best Abstract Session** will be granted 8 minutes for presentation, followed by 2 minutes for discussion.
- **Video Presentations** will be granted 8 minutes for presentation, followed by 2 minutes for discussion.
- **Non-discussed Video Presentations** 8-minute video presentation
- **Discussed E-poster Presentations** will be displayed as digital e-posters on poster stations and will be granted a 2-minute presentation, followed by 1 minute for discussion during one of the dedicated e-poster sessions.
- **Non-discussed E-posters** will be displayed as digital e-posters on poster stations and on the meeting website.

### Oral Presentations

If you are presenting an **Oral Presentation**, please observe the following points:

- Declare any relevant links to industry or other conflicts of interest before beginning your presentation. You need to have a disclosure slide in the beginning of your presentation.
- Do not exceed the time limits of your presentation, which is 4 minutes. If you exceed the time limit, you will be interrupted by the Chair.
- Please note that only digital Microsoft PowerPoint for Windows or digital video files (MP4, MOV, AVI) are possible. Mac-based presentations must be converted for PC use.
- We recommend that you use the latest version of Microsoft PowerPoint for Windows to develop your presentation. If you are using embedded video clips in your presentation, please ensure that this file is included in your PowerPoint file or include/submit your video files separately (we recommend saving a copy of the original video file with your PowerPoint presentation just in case).
- Slides must be submitted to the staff in the Speaker's room at least 2 hours prior to the session. You can bring your PowerPoint slides on flash drive (preferably in the ratio of 16:9). It will not be permitted to connect your own personal notebook.
- We recommend that you store an accessible copy of your presentation in the cloud (e.g. webmail, dropbox, Google drive, etc.).

### Video Presentations

If you are presenting a **Video Presentation**, please observe the following points:

- Maximum duration of the video: 8 minutes
- File cannot be above the 500 MB
- Videos must have English captions or narration
- Please ensure that your videos protect patient anonymity and integrity
- The preferred resolution is 1280x720p (16:9 aspect ratio) HD video
- Acceptable file formats are mp4, avi and mpeg4
- If you present in a video session, please submit your final video in the Speaker's room at least 2 hours prior to the session.
- If you present a non-discussed video, please submit your final version of the video by sending the file to [meeting@issm.info](mailto:meeting@issm.info) or by uploading the file via [issm.wetransfer.com](http://issm.wetransfer.com) before **February 5, 2026**.



## Discussed E-poster Presentations

Discussed e-poster presentations will be granted a 2-minute presentation, followed by 1 minute for discussion during one of the dedicated e-poster sessions. During your 2-minute presentation, we will display your poster on the screen. Note that PowerPoint presentations will not be accepted for these sessions. We advise you to use the [template poster file when](#) creating your poster. However, note that all e-posters need to be in landscape format with aspect ratio 16:9 and saved as high resolution files (minimal 1920x1080 pixels).

In order to give all participants the opportunity to view all posters without any hurry, all posters will be published at digital poster stations during the meeting and on the official meeting website. Please submit a digital version of your poster by sending the file to [meeting@issm.info](mailto:meeting@issm.info) or by uploading the file via [issm.wetransfer.com](https://www.issm.wetransfer.com) **before February 5, 2026**. Please note that you do not have to bring a hard copy of the poster.

## Non-discussed E-poster Presentations

We advise you to use the [template poster file when](#) creating your poster. However, note that all e-posters need to be in landscape format with aspect ratio 16:9 and saved as high resolution files (minimal 1920x1080 pixels).

All posters will be published at digital poster stations during the meeting and on the official meeting website. Please submit a digital version of your poster by sending the file to [meeting@issm.info](mailto:meeting@issm.info) or by uploading the file via [issm.wetransfer.com](https://www.issm.wetransfer.com) **before February 5, 2026**. Please note that you do not have to bring a hard copy of the poster.
